This project involved the renovation of standard office space into a highly classified, ultra-modern operations center. The Center's primary function is to enable 24-hour worldwide visualization, planning, and execution of coordinated information operations for the U.S. Army and other federal agencies.

The main work area has a multi-tiered design with custom workstations and support areas. A Mission Readiness Room with virtual reality and holographic capabilities is adjacent to the main IDC floor.

The futuristic, yet distinctly military, setting is further reinforced by the Commander's console, which gives the illusion that one has boarded a star ship. The prominently positioned chair provides the commanding officer an uninterrupted field of vision to a 22'-0" wide projection screen.
