AFP's goals for their new office included locating their staff in attractive, contiguous space with clear circulation, providing natural light to all staff, and providing adequate access to conference space.

The perimeter offices were designed with glass storefronts, and low furniture panels were used at the window walls. To open up the work areas, a partial open ceiling with exposed ductwork, lights, and structure was designed. The curved, free-flowing ceiling adds height and color to the areas. Pendant light fixtures and accent lighting highlight the open ceiling crevasses.

The palette of soft, warm colors used throughout the space is an opposite reaction to the gray and white interior that AFP left behind.
