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When DBI was hired to design the new Cassidy Turley office in Fairfax, Virginia, the main objective was to mirror the look and feel of their recently completed corporate headquarters in Washington, DC.

DBI selected less-expensive materials to match the color palette of Cassidy Turley's headquarters while maintaining the project's budget requirements without compromising the level of visual interest. All spaces were designed to be simple and modern, using a palette of cool white marbles, warm eucalyptus wood veneer, pale beige-gray carpets, and cream ceramic tile flooring. Glass was used heavily to maintain a visual connection among interior spaces and between the interior and exterior.

Though not a LEED-certified project, many sustainable design elements were incorporated into this build out.
