Since this space overlooks a golf course and is surrounded by trees, the design concept was to bring as much of the natural environment into the space as possible, thus creating “an office in the trees”. While the office palette remains neutral, the trees provide the accent color with the changing of the seasons. Due to the irregular column layout, the columns were captured within a three-foot deep wall that also provides the library storage for the Design Studio. This 140’ long wall separates the reception and conference rooms from the Design Studio. By leaving the structure and ductwork exposed in the Design Studio, the focus of the space is the view to the outside environment.

The design is also about fostering communication and collaboration – from the conference rooms to the team room, from the coffee bar to the open worktables.
