The main objective of this project was to create an efficient, open studio that promotes collaboration and creative success. The main public corridor bisects the floor running east to west. Rhythmic pilasters occur at regular intervals throughout the space and connect to the ceiling lighting covers. The corridor also serves as a display area for the firm's large portfolio.

All spaces were designed to be simple and modern. The neutral palette was chosen to avoid competing with the design projects worked on within the space. The palette of warm grays and golden maples is in high contrast to the raw, cream-colored open plenum that spans over 80% of the studio. Most hard walls are glass or incorporate a clerestory light panel to preserve the visual connection among workspaces. Vibrant blue accents throughout offer visual contrast and stimulation.
