This new facility was the second building on CFC's campus. The new building was sited at an angle to the existing facility in order to create a central court and avoid a parallel, static composition. The terraces of the two buildings were choreographed, fanning out towards the west, thus creating a motion in the design. This concept of motion culminated in a sweeping white canopy that draws visitors to the entry of the building.

The skin of the building was derived from a multi-level system of mullions. Walls of glass without mullions separate blocks defined by the intricate mullion system. Concrete fin walls and piers were introduced to contrast and complement the curtainwall system.

Randall Mars Architects served as design architect on this project.
