This space was conceived with universality and flexibility in mind, but was developed so the fixed parts of the plan are bold and interactive with one another. Among the most important design features are intense flashes of color.



The plan used urban design concepts, creating a grid of “generic space” (workstations) punctuated by “civic spaces” (reception, conference rooms, etc.) that are located off grid, and “infrastructure” spaces (LAN, pantries, laboratories) located in boldly shaped and colored volumes that are “landmarks” providing orientation and space definition. The clusters of workstations provide the infill spaces that are reconfigurable without altering the basic “street grid”. The main avenues also act as gathering places for informal meetings and discussions.
